
University of Virginia graduated students on the Aetna student health plan are able to utilize this plan until July 31, 2022, when the plan year ends.

Once this plan ends, there are options to consider such as:


- Enroll in a plan at www.healthcare.gov (see sample plans below).
- Enroll in Medicaid with your state of residence. Income qualification for Virginia Medicaid is \$17,784 for one adult/no children household; \$30,312 for 3-person family with 1 adult.

- Enroll in parent's plan if current age is below 26

You may view options available at https://www.healthcare.gov/see-plans/#/ by entering generic information and viewing options without having to complete an application. Below are options available based on information entered as: Student age 26 with an income of \$22K residing in the Charlottesville, VA area.

The below plans are similar in deductible amount to the Aetna student health plan of \$350, and both premiums are lower than the monthly amount of the student plan which calculates to \$262.33 (\$3148/12) for 2021/2022.



The below plan has a very high deductible but as you can see the monthly premium amount is zero.
